**91** The 2006 Pinot Noir Arcus Estate is dark ruby-colored with floral notes, fennel, black cherry, and black raspberry. The most structured of these wines, it also has savory flavors, excellent depth, and a fruit-filled finish. It will be at its peak from 2012 to 2020.

**90** A very pretty and airy red berry fruit nose, nuanced by intense briar and earth notes that complement well the moderately full and rich flavors that are supported by dusty and ripe tannins that are presently edgy but this should harmonize of the next 3 + years. 2012+

**92** The Arcus Estate is planted to self-rooted Pommard and Dijon clones on steep hillsides. The wine is aged 11 months in 79 percent new French oak. The wine is a brilliant dark magenta with a rose colored rim. It's lightly aromatic with wild scents of spice, dark red fruit, and fennel. The attack is soft and lush, and the finish is very long and lovely with well-integrated flavors of fruit and wood.
