91 A tinge of herb, accenting black cherry aromas suggests this wine still needs to find its legs. With extensive air, the fruit takes on a red currant hue; the texture becomes fleshy, the oak finely rendered, with good acidity and a tangy minerality. It's all there - just needs time to knit.
